A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE

OF TERRITORY TO THE PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
WITHOUT NOTICE OR HEARING OR ELECTION

TRACT 2671 ANNEXATION

RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Pinedale County
Water District, Fresno County California, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Directors of the Pinedale
County Water District finds and determines:

(a) Preliminary proceedings for annexation of certain
described territory to the Pinedale County Water District were
initiated by the filing of a resolution of application adopted by
this Board on September 26, 1977, with the Local Agency Formation
Commission in the County of Fresno, pursuant to the requirements
of the District reorganization act.

(b) Thereafter, appropriate proceedings were conducted
by said Local Agency Formation Commission and the said Commission on
May 24th, 1978, duly adopted a resolution approving the proposed
annexation and assigning to the proposed annexation, the distinctive
short form designation "TRACT 2671 ANNEXATION".

(c) Pursuant to Government Code section 56261 all of the
owners of land within the territory proposed to be annexed have
consented to the proposed annexation.

(d) Pursuant to the statutes cited, the Commission in
approving the proposal has authorized this Board of Directors to
annex said territory without notice or hearing by this Board and
without an election.

(e) The territory proposed to be annexed is uninhabited

such term is defined in Government Code section 56074.

(f) Pursuant to Government Code section 56322, this Board of Directors should order the annexation of the territory described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof completed without notice or hearing and without an election to confirm the order of annexation.

Section 2. The Board of Directors of the Pinedale County Water District therefore hereby resolves and orders:

(a) The territory hereinbefore described should be, and it hereby is, ordered annexed to the Pinedale County Water District.

(b) Pursuant to government Code section 56322, this annexation is ordered without notice or hearing and without election.

(c) The Secretary is directed to certify to the passage of this resolution.

(d) The President of the Board of Directors is authorized to request the Local Agency Formation Commission of Fresno County to complete the annexation herein ordered as provided by law.

(e) The use of the regular Fresno County Assessment roll is ordered with respect to the aforescribed property.

(f) Said aforescribed property will not be taxed for existing bonded indebtedness or contractual obligations of the Pinedale County Water District.

Proposed annexation of "Tract 2671" to Pinedale County Water District.

PROPONENT

Eugene Adams, Attorney for Pinedale County Water District.

ACREAGE & LOCATION

Approximately 9.80 acres, located west of Blackstone and Sierra Avenues.

PURPOSE

To provide district sewer services to a developing residential planned unit development subdivision of 96 units.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

Approve the proposed annexation to be known as the "Tract 2671" to the Pinedale County Water District.

Ratify the action of the Executive Officer in holding this unpublished hearing (Sec. 56261 Gov't. Code).

Authorize the District to initiate subsequent proceedings without notice, hearing and/or election (Sec. 56261 Gov't. Code).

FINDINGS

Boundaries are definite and certain.

Territory is uninhabited.

Proposed annexation is contiguous to the present boundaries of the Pinedale County Water District.

There are no conflicts with lines of assessment or ownership.

Pinedale County Water District Board consents to the filing of this proposal.

The proposal conforms with the recommendation of the district sphere of influence determined by your Commission.

The Pinedale County Water District Board has certified that it has received written consent from the property owner involved in this proposal.

Assessor certifies that Sierra North Village is the owner of and represents 100% of the assessed value of lands described in the proposal.

A negative declaration of environmental impact has been assigned to Tract 2671 by County of Fresno staff. Based on the information in the environmental document for that tract, your Executive Officer finds that the proposed project is an activity which would not have a significant effect on the environment and is, therefore, not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION BY
PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT THE
LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TAKE PROCEEDINGS
FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO THE DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the PINEDALE COUNTY DISTRICT, Fresno County, California, that;

WHEREAS, the District proposes to initiate preliminary proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965, Title 6, Division 1, of the Government Code of the State of California, (commencing with Section 56000) for annexation of territory described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "territory");

WHEREAS, the territory proposed to be annexed is uninhabited as such term is defined in the Government Code, Section 56074, and a description of the exterior boundaries of the territory is set forth in EXHIBIT "A";

WHEREAS, because of the geographical location of the territory to be annexed, the District can adequately and economically furnish services which are needed within the territory.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, as follows:

1. That this Resolution of Application be, and it is, hereby adopted by the Board of Directors of the PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, and the LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION, be, and it is hereby, requested to take proceedings for the annexation of the territory described in said EXHIBIT "A", in the manner provided by the District of Reorganization Act of 1965.

2. That the reasons for this proposed change of organization are as follows;

- (a) The PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT is authorized and empowered to provide for the supply, storage, and distribution of water for domestic and fire protection use, the collection, pumping, treatment, and disposal of sewage, and has a system and works for the providing

of distribution facilities which may be expanded so as to provide a means of water service, and has a sewage and disposal system capable of being expanded to serve the territory proposed to be annexed.

- (b) The territory proposed to be annexed to the PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT is presently without a regular system for the supply of water for domestic and fire protection purposes, and sewage treatment and disposal, and which area has a need of a reliable source of water supply and distribution facilities and sewage treatment disposal. The provision of regular water and sewage disposal is essential to the continued use of the property.
- (c) The lands within the territory proposed to be annexed are susceptible of service by water facilities and sewage treatment and disposal facilities of the PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, or practicable works in connection therewith, and will be benefited by such service.

3. That the Secretary of the District be, and is, hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Executive Officer of the Fresno County Local Agency Formation Commission.

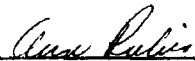

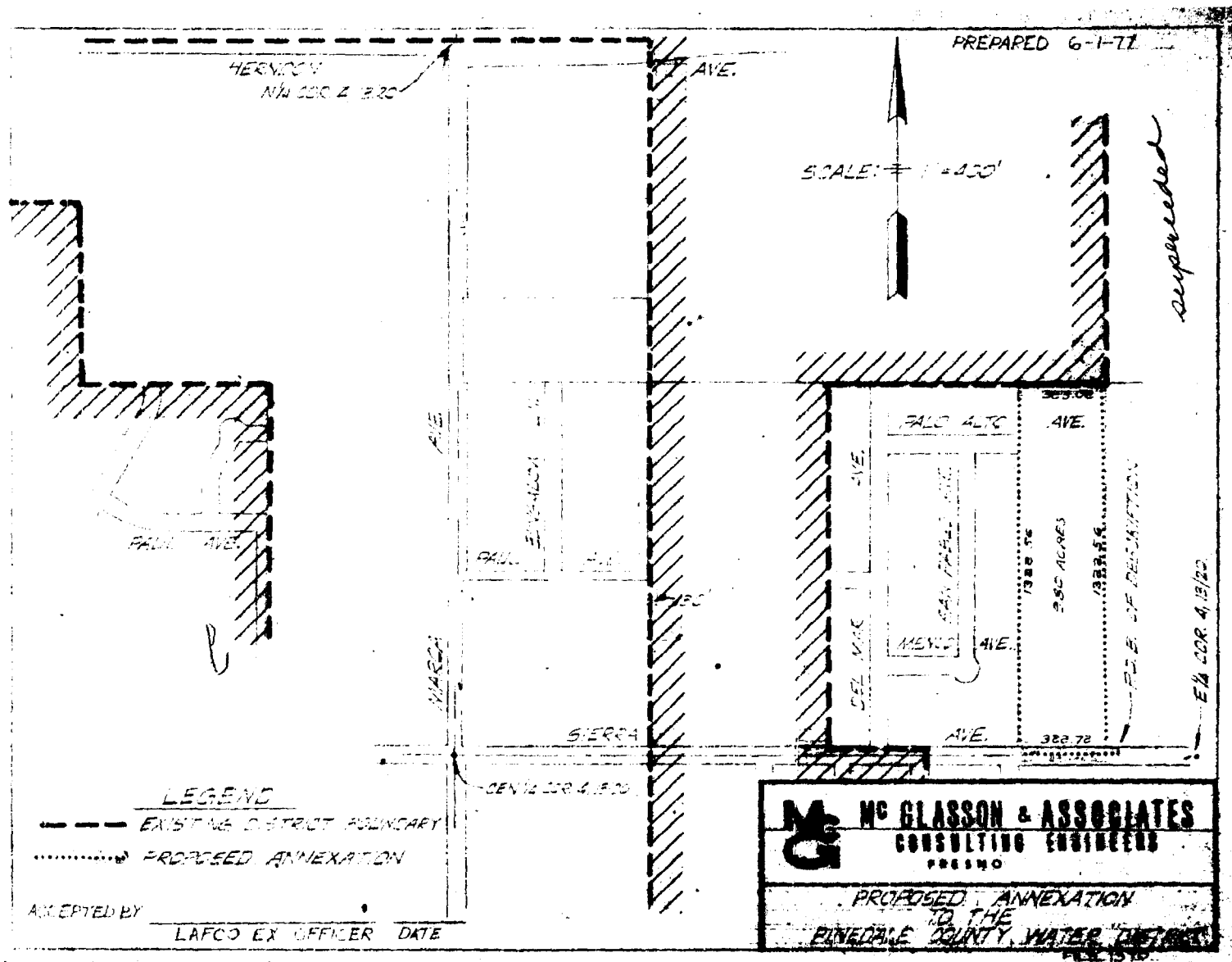
