2 PINEDALE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ) LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

3 WHEREAS, an annexation proposal known as the YMCA Annexation to  
4 Pinedale County Water District was heretofore filed with this  
5 Commission; and

6 WHEREAS, the petitioner is the sole owner of the land proposed  
7 to be annexed to the district; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 56261 of the Government Code authorizes this  
9 Commission to approve such annexation without notice or hearing; and

10 WHEREAS, this Commission, upon review of the application has  
11 determined that the application is in order.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, the Fresno County Local Agency Formation Com-  
13 mission does hereby resolve, determine and order as follows:

14 Section 1: The boundaries as set forth in the proposal are  
15 approved.

16 Section 2: For purposes of annexation, the territory is found  
17 to be uninhabited.

18 Section 3: The YMCA annexation to Pinedale County Water District  
19 is approved as submitted.

20 Section 4: The Pinedale County Water District is the conducting  
21 district and may annex the territory without notice, hearing or  
22 election.

23 Section 5: Further proceedings may be conducted and completed  
24 pursuant to applicable law. Pursuant to Section 54799.2 of the  
25 Government Code, the proceeding must be completed within one year  
26 from this date.

27 Section 6: The Executive Officer is hereby directed to mail

A request for hearing not having been received, it is recommended that the proposed annexation to Pinedale County Water District (AD-67) be approved. It is further recommended that the resolution of approval authorize the conducting district to complete the annexation without notice, hearing and election.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY  
FORMATION COMMISSION OF FRESNO COUNTY  
CONDUCT PROCEEDINGS TO ACCOMPLISH  
ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO THE PINEDALE  
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

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WHEREAS, on the 27th day of November, 1967 representatives of the owners of certain property hereinafter described requested that the Pinedale County Water District take appropriate action to accomplish the annexation of certain hereinafter described real property to the Pinedale County Water District, and

WHEREAS, said territory is more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, said territory is uninhabited territory, and

WHEREAS, the reason for the proposed annexation is to enable the Pinedale County Water District to provide sewer service, water service and garbage and rubbish disposal service for said territory, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Pinedale County Water District hereby finds and determines that it would be in the best interest of said territory and Pinedale County Water District for said territory to be annexed to the Pinedale County Water District.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Pinedale County Water District as follows:

1. That the local agency formation commission of Fresno County be and it is hereby requested to take all appropriate proceedings to accomplish the annexation of said territory described in said Exhibit "A" to the Pinedale County Water District.

2. This Resolution to take effect immediately.

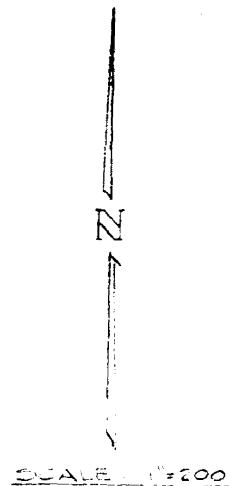
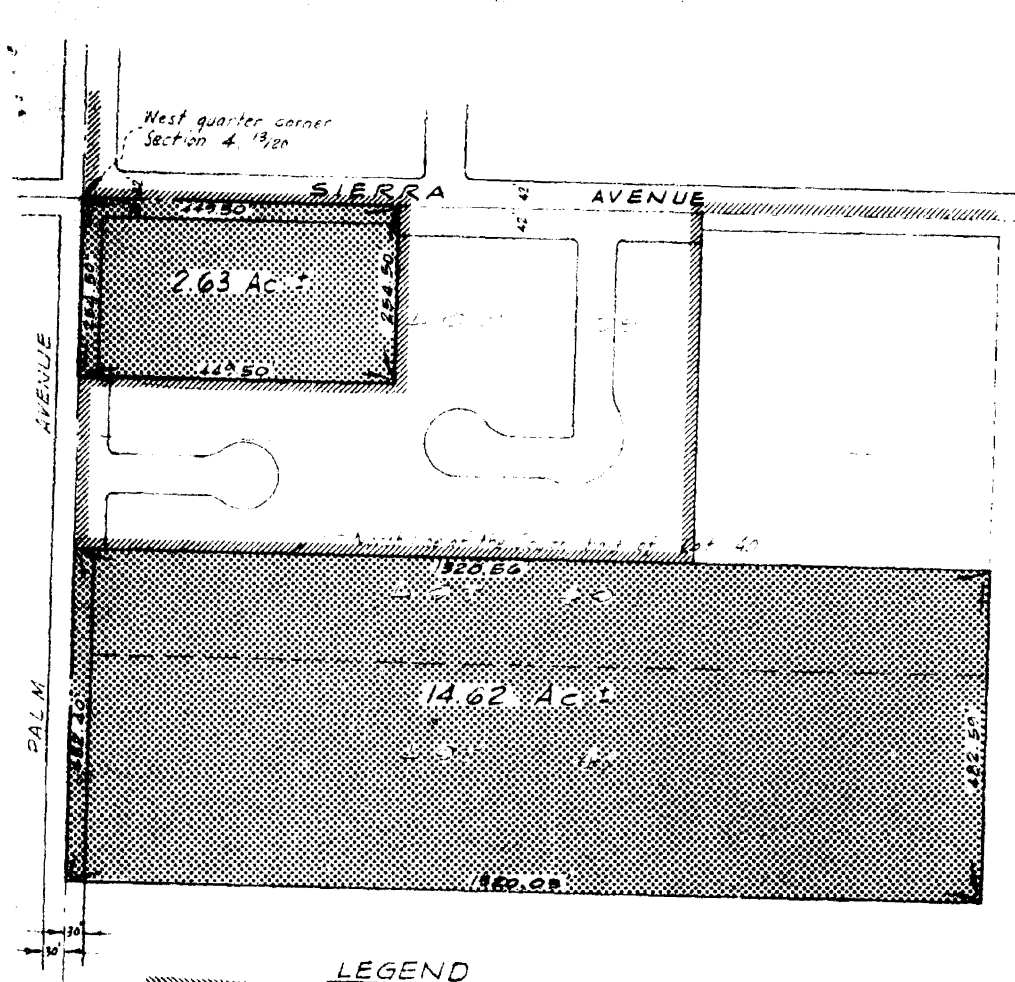
